Highlights

- Children and adolescents (18 y/o and below) with disabilities received their Typhoon Surigae Family Kits through collaborative efforts with Palau Parents Empowered (PPE-an NGO of parents of children with disabilities) and Palau Community Action Agency (PCAA) Head Start.
- Family Kit distribution to members of OMEKESANG, an NGO of persons living with disabilities, also began with OMEKESANG board officers and PRCS staff making home deliveries.

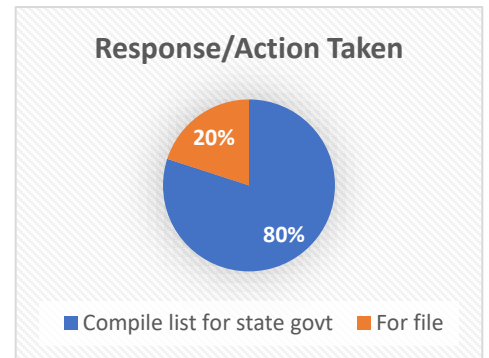
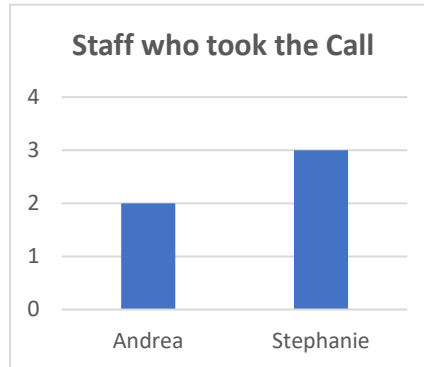
